Dear Aretha Franklin Participants, Families, and Group Home Staff,

You have signed your child/ward up for the Aretha Franklin event on Sunday, March 13, 2022. The location/host of that event requires (1) government-issued photo ID and (2) proof of full vaccination for every attendee or (3) a negative COVID PCR test taken no more than 72 hours prior to the performance. No at home COVID tests will be accepted. As such, you child/ward must bring those documents on the date of the event. By sending your child/ward with the documents, you agree and consent that they will be shared with SSSRA, the location/host for the purpose of your child/ward being admitted to the program/event location, and/or any other individual deemed necessary by SSSRA to participate in activities before, during, or after the event. You also understand and agree that if your child/ward does not have the documents upon arrival, your child/ward will be unable to attend and will be sent home with you.

Full vaccination is defined as two weeks passing either from one dose of the J&J vaccine or two weeks passing from the second dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines. Proof of vaccination can be a vaccination card, vaccination record from a healthcare provider, or medical record showing proof of vaccination. SSSRA is not responsible for lost IDs or vaccination records. The negative COVID test must show the date administered, no more than 72 prior to the event date, and must show the participant's name.

Participants will be responsible for holding on to both the IDs and the vaccination record or the negative results for the duration of the program/special event. Photo copies of vaccination cards and IDs are acceptable as long as they are readable in the copies.
